Environmental Policy

Broadridge Financial Solutions, Inc. (“Broadridge,” the “Company” or “we”) recognizes the importance of addressing climate change and improving our environmental footprint. Broadridge seeks to focus on the following practices and principles to support our sustainability.

Governance

The Company’s Board of Directors (the “Board”) and the Governance and Nominating Committee of the Board oversee Broadridge’s ongoing commitment to environmental and climate-related matters as part of their oversight of overall Environmental, Social and Governance matters (“ESG matters”) of the Company. Our Environmental, Social and Governance Committee, a cross-functional executive committee of the Company (the “ESG Committee”), reports regularly to the Governance and Nominating Committee and annually to the Board on ESG matters, including climate-related issues, initiatives and strategy.

Climate Strategy and Risk and Opportunity Assessment

- Regularly assess and manage climate-related risks and opportunities associated with our business and disclose such climate-related risks and opportunities in line with the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosure framework;
- Measure and analyze Scope 1, 2, and material Scope 3 greenhouse gas (“GHG”) emissions categories as well as work towards developing emissions reduction targets and goals; and
- Aligning our business strategy with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (“SDGs”), including SDG 12 (ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns).

Clients, Vendors and Associates

- Focus on digitization and providing eco-friendly services and products;
- Encouraging our vendors to be accountable to environmental management principles through our Vendor Code of Conduct;
- Mitigating our environmental footprint throughout the supply chain;
- Foster a company culture where our associates promote education and awareness through peer engagement opportunities to address environmental challenges; and
- Providing opportunities for our associates to participate in environmental awareness initiatives.

Compliance and Climate Reporting and Disclosure

- Providing transparency through environmental reporting, including Carbon Disclosure Project Reports;
- Hold ourselves accountable at the highest environmental, safety and protection standards;
- Operate in compliance with all applicable U.S. Environmental Protection Agency-mandated environmental reporting requirements at our production facilities; and
- Monitor emerging climate-related rules and regulations.
